decline in high-quality friendships. "In 1985, most Americans had about three people with whom they could share everything. Tragically, by the start of this century, 25 percent of Americans said that they had no one to fully confide in."

This leaves many wondering if technology is making us lonelier. Instead of socializing, we're perhaps sitting home surfing other people's supposedly happy lives on FB. Digital media now consumes 5 ½ hours of our day and a study of female college students found they spend 10 hours a day on their cellphones.

Some of this is driven by FOMO, which stands for "fear of missing out". Roll that around in your head. I found the concept very amusing when I first heard it—less so when I spent a little time applying it to myself. For an idea junkie like me, all that's going on and being discovered and opined keeps me in an over-stimulated whirlwind. Think about your own lives and your children's and grandchildren's! Not only may their personal relationships be less rewarding than ours have been, studies are now showing that all the time spent on computers is changing children's brains. Whether that change is for better or worse remains to be seen. Some researchers feel that the new, constantly engaged, "busy" brain may be necessary to succeed in our new much faster-paced world. Others worry that a brain constantly engaged will wreck havoc on our ability to quiet and comfort ourselves and who knows what else—it's uncharted water. That's pretty fascinating, and scary!

The good news? I'm pretty sure that even if Facebook taketh away actual friends and confidants, Newcomers will still provide them in joyful abundance. If you're new in town or lonely, get off your cell phone and reach out. We offer friendship and fun events almost every day of the month. Just check the calendar on page 14 and see.

With happy expectations of new "interpersonal relationships" with those I don't yet know, I wish all my existing Newcomer "Valentines" a very happy February!
