**Details:** On this first day of Autumn, we are going to head

to southeast Austin for a lovely walk. Set back from Slaughter Lane, Mary Moore Searight Metropolitan Park is 344 acres of fields, trees and wildlife. The park is the lasting legacy of its namesake. The city of Austin purchased 88 acres from Searight using a Texas Parks and Wildlife

Department grant. Searight donated an additional 206 acres. The city named the park after her in November 1988. Newspaper articles at the time had compared the acquisition's significance to that of Zilker Park. This is a very picturesque walk where many of the live oaks are festooned with Spanish moss.
