

## The March Luncheon Meeting is For the Birds

Our guest speaker for the March luncheon meeting will be Nicole Netherton, Executive Director of Travis Audubon, the independent Austin-area chapter of the National Audubon Society. Nicole always noticed birds as a child, but got really interested in birding while living in New York City in the early 2000s. Her favorite bird is the Scissor-tailed Flycatcher or Carolina Wren, depending on the day. A Native Houstonian, she was educated at The University of Texas at Austin and had a long career in marketing before moving to the nonprofit world in 2016. She has been in her current role since 2018, but has been a member of Travis Audubon Society since she moved back to Texas in 2009. Nicole has also



started noticing fungi and slime molds on her pandemic nature walks—they are much easier to photograph than birds! She is also active in lots of groups and activities in Allandale, where she lives with her two (totally indoor) cats, Frankenstein

#### **Plate by Dzintra**

The first thing you notice after you open the bright red doors to Plate is the lovely, large crystal chandelier that graces the entryway, complete with a fireplace and cozy waiting area. Just beyond is the well-stocked bar and glimpses of the Garden and Paris rooms, two of the three indoor dining areas to choose from. The third area is the chef's table in front of the kitchen, where you can watch the chefs at their trade. Lastly, there is an outdoor patio overlooking a pond and hill country flora. The décor is lovely and welcoming and gives you the feeling that you will have a great dining experience. Good news, you will! Plate is owned by Executive Chef Dzintra Dzenis. She studied at Le Cordon Bleu in Paris and graduated with honors in both cuisine and pastry. Dzenis appeared on the 6<sup>th</sup> season of The Food Network Star in 2010 and was a Star finalist on the show. Shortly after that, she relocated to Austin with her family, had a supper club out of her home and then decided to open Plate.





Not only does Plate serve lunch and dinner, there is also a Gourmet Market and Café, featuring all-day casual dining as well as on-site take away. Catered events are also offered at Plate.

Food is always made from scratch, (including sauces, crusts and ice cream) and from fresh, unprocessed ingredients. I found out that they use in season local foods after I had raved to someone about their caprese salad, only to find out that it was off the menu as it became off season. I highly recommend it when it reappears.

I've enjoyed the tender and delicious rack of lamb, and the generous macadamia crusted chicken. For a recent lunch, I had the mushroom quiche, and it was proba-

bly the tastiest quiche I've ever had. The tuna sandwich was good. Their appetizers sound like mains and you could probably have one or two and be satisfied. The dinners include Lobster Risotto, Beef Wellington, Salmon Veracruz, Halibut Mazatlan, all with starches, gravies and vegetables included. Yum!

Plate is a great place for a special night out. It is a bit higher priced and if you go on a busy Saturday night, the acoustics are not the best. Otherwise, it's a lovely place to dine and have a memorable meal.


